

FOARD COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATES FROM THE JUDGES OFFICE

As many of you know, on April 27th, Governor Greg Abbott addressed the State on "Opening back Texas." In his address, he put in new directives in his "Executive Order GA-18." On re-opening Texas, starting May 1st, phase I – re-open businesses, retailers, restaurants, movie theatres, all at a 25% capacity (if they choose.) Museums and Libraries may open if permitted by local government at 25% capacity. The Governor also did not allow barbershops, salons, gyms and bars to re-open since he did not deem them safe yet. As we re-open Foard County businesses, and restaurants, let us continue to act responsibly as we re-engage in the economy, to continue following all the health precautions and sanitizing guidelines and care for our vulnerable neighbors.
