PURSUANT to the TEXAS OPEN MEETING ACT, public notice is herein given that the Foard County Commissioner's Court will conduct a regular meeting of said Court on Wednesday January 28th, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. in the County Judge's and Commissioner's Courtroom (DOWNSTAIRS), Foard County Courthouse, Crowell, Texas.

Public Notice is further given that the agenda was posted upon the Courthouse Bulletin Board on Thursday, January 22nd, 2026, at 2:30 P.M. on the upper and lower west doors. Additionally, the required public notice time frame is exclusive to any day on which the Courthouse is closed, such as holidays, or weekends falling within 72 hours in advance of regular or special meetings of the Court.

Public Matters which were placed on this Agenda at least 72 hours prior to this meeting of the Court, which may receive both consideration and action by the Court as follows:


- A. Approve the minutes from the previous meeting.
- B. Public comment on any agenda items.
- C. Discuss and take action, if necessary, with TX Dot Representative.
- D. Discuss and take action, if necessary, with the TDEM representative.
- E. Discuss and take action, if necessary, with the Sheriff Department.
- F. Discuss and take action if necessary on approving Treasurer's report for December 2025.
- G. Discuss and take action if necessary adopting the Resolution Supporting Legislation to Exempt Texas Counties from the State Hotel Occupancy Tax.
- H. Review and approve all bills and payroll for the road hands and the courthouse employees.
- I. Other items of discussion.
- J. Adjourn

II. Pursuant to the authority granted under the Government Code, Chap. 551, the Commissioner's court may convene a closed session to discuss any of the above agenda items. Immediately before any closed session the specific section or sections of Government Code, Chap. 551, that provides statutory authority will be announced.

III. Please note that while any member of the public is invited to meet with and discuss public matters with the Court, no formal action can be taken by the Court unless the matter is placed upon the Agenda of the Court and public notice is given in advance of any action requested by the Court.

The agenda and its required advance public notice are governed by the Texas Open Meetings Act which requires that the agenda be posted upon the Courthouse Bulletin Board at least 72 hours prior to regular and special meetings of the Court and 2 hours prior to emergency meetings in which an unforeseen emergency adversely affects public safety, public services or public property.
