Others present were; Cheryl Branch- Judges office, Perry Shaw-Foard County Sheriff, Karen Baylor-County Attorney, Wesley Kajs- TX Dot, and Ralph Price-Secure Tech.

(A) Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Motion to accept was made by Commissioner Tamplen and seconded by Commissioner Johnson, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(B) No comments on the day's agenda from the public. **No Action Taken.**

(C) TxDOT representative Wesley Kajs has surplus LRA that the State will donate to the County. Judge Christopher also is going to setup a in person meeting with TX Dot Mr. Herbstreet to discuss Foard County projects that have not been schedule.

(D) TDEM representative Elsa Werley- Absent

(E) Sheriff Shaw reported the delivery date for the Polaris should be by the end of this week. Also, discussed was the purchase of a cargo trailer to store/haul the Polaris. Sheriff Shaw will get quotes. The Sheriff Office/City Police did a program at the school this morning and handed out donuts to the kids as they were arriving at school. **No Action Taken on these items.**

(F) Treasurer's report from September was then reviewed. Motion to accept was made by Commissioner Wisdom and seconded by Commissioner Haynie, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(G) The Commissioners then welcomed Ralph Price a representative from Secure Tech. The Courthouse security system needs updating. Mr. Price said it has been 10 years since the last updating of the equipment. The update will cost approximately \$14,000.00. Motion to accept was made by Commissioner Haynie and seconded by Commissioner Tamplen, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(H) The Commissioner discussed the equipment pay off. This needs to be done as soon as the paperwork is completed. Motion to accept was made by Commissioner Johnson and seconded by Commissioner Haynie, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(I) County Attorney Karen Baylor then discussed that she has received her funds from the SB22 program. She is looking to hire either a full-time or part-time employees with this money. The Commissioners agreed for her to move forward with the employment. Motion was made by Commissioner Wisdom and seconded by Commissioner Johnson, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(J) County bills and payroll was then reviewed. Motion to accept was made by Commissioner Haynie and seconded by Commissioner Wisdom, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**

(K) No other items of discussion. **No Action.**

(L) With no other items of discussion motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Wisdom and seconded by Commissioner Johnson, with all in favor. **Motion Carried.**
