TO ANY ATTORNEY CONDUCTING PROBATE PROCEEDINGS IN FLOYD COUNTY:

To establish guidelines that are equal to all parties, to secure the original integrity of documents and to provide faster service to parties involved, the Floyd County Court establishes the following guidelines for conducting a probate proceeding:

- 1. For a Probate with Letters of Testamentary the following items will be bench filed by the Court:
 - A. The Order and
 - B. The Oath of Executor.
- 2. For a Probate by Muniment of Title only the Order will be bench filed.

<u>ALL</u> other documents must be e-filed.

<u>These guidelines are effective June 1,2018.</u> If questions arise, feel free to direct them to my office.
