PURSUANT to the Texas Open Meetings Act, public notice is herein given that the Foard County Commissioner's Court will conduct a SPECIAL meeting of said Court **Monday May 11th, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.** in the County Judge's and Commissioner's Court Courtroom (**downstairs**) in the Foard County Courthouse Crowell, Texas. Public notice is further given that the agenda was posted upon the Courthouse Bulletin Board and upper and lower West doors of the courthouse on Tuesday May 11th, 2026, 2:30 p.m., the same being 72 hours prior to this meeting.

- I. Public matters which were placed upon this Agenda at least 72 hours prior to this meeting of the Court which may receive both formal consideration and formal action by the Court are as follows:
- A. Conduct Public Hearing on the Creation of a Reinvestment Zone to be known as Foard County Reinvestment Zone-BRP Seine BESS for purposes of tax abatement to provide economic development within the county, sited on approximately 162.831 acres of land approximately 4 miles southwest of the city of Crowell in Foard County. This application covers all qualified property in the reinvestment zone and project boundary within Foard County necessary for the commercial operations of the proposed BESS project.

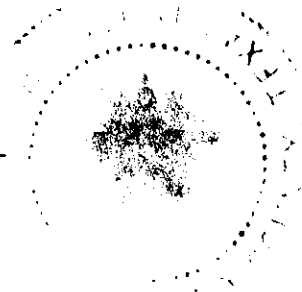
II. Please note that while any member of the public is invited to both meet with the Court and discuss public matters with the Court, no formal action can be taken by the Court on the matter unless the matter is placed upon the formal Agenda of the Court and public notice is given in advance of any formal action requested by the Court.

The formal Agenda and its required advance public notice are governed by the Texas Open Meetings Act which requires that the agenda be posted upon the Courthouse Bulletin Board at least 72 hours prior to regular and special meetings of the Court and 2 hours prior to emergency meetings in which an un for seen emergency adversely affects public safety, public services, or public property. Additionally, the required public notice frame is exclusive of any days on which the Courthouse is closed such as holidays or weekends falling within 72 hours in advance of regular or special meetings of the Court.


- A. Approve the minutes from the previous meeting.
